Hot Springs Area Quilt Guild – Minutes – March 27, 2011

- 1 yard outer fabric . . . Something bright and fun!
- 1 yard lining fabric
- 1 yard insulated fleece
 - hancocks: insul fleece \$6.99/yd.
 - hobby lobby: insulbright
- Thread
- Hand sewing needle
- Sewing maching and sewing supplies
- Iron and ironing board

If your sewing machine has the capability and you want to learn a little about free motion machine quilting bring:
2 sets 12"x12" layered fabric (fabric-batting-fabric). I use muslin for this.
These are to be practice pieces

ESTERITA AUSTIN TO VISIT HOT SPRINGS VILLAGE- The internationally famous quilt artist Estrita Austin (www.esteritaaustin.com) will be teaching classes on May, 2, 3, and 4 at Christ Lutheran Church, 103 Ponferrada Way, Hot Springs Village. She will be teaching portraits in two different techniques and fabrics; cotton fabrics on Monday and Sheer fabrics on Tuesday. A landscape class will be on Wednesday. Private lessons can be arranged on Thursday or Friday. The cost of this three day workshop will be \$240 although this charge may be reduced significantly depending on the total number of students. You must sign up for all three days and send a deposit of \$100 to secure your place. Kits will be available for \$35, which will supply you with most of the materials and some of the fabrics (all of the sheers) that you will need, please see supply and kit list for details. This is a class at which beginners to advanced can succeed, guaranteed. No sewing machine required, just a sense of play!
