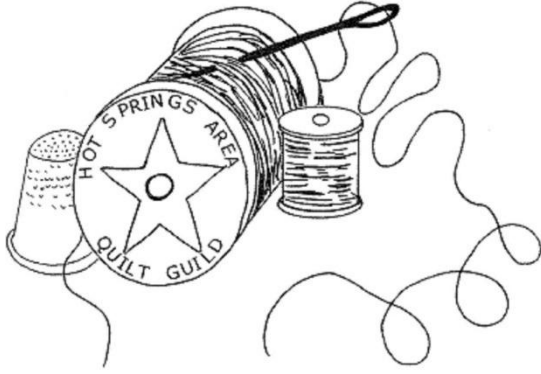

ESTERITA AUSTIN TO VISIT HOT SPRINGS VILLAGE- The internationally famous quilt artist Estrita Austin (www.esteritaaustin.com) will be teaching classes on May, 2, 3, and 4 at Christ Lutheran Church, 103

Ponferrada Way, Hot Springs Village. She will be teaching portraits in two different techniques and fabrics; cotton fabrics on Monday and Sheer fabrics on Tuesday. A landscape class will be on Wednesday. Private lessons can be arranged on Thursday or Friday. The cost of this three day workshop will be \$240 although this charge may be reduced significantly depending on the total number of students. You must sign up for all three days and send a deposit of \$100 to secure your place. Kits will be available for \$35, which will supply you with most of the materials and some of the fabrics (all of the sheers) that you will need, please see supply and kit list for details. This is a class at which beginners to advanced can succeed, guaranteed. No sewing machine required, just a sense of play!
