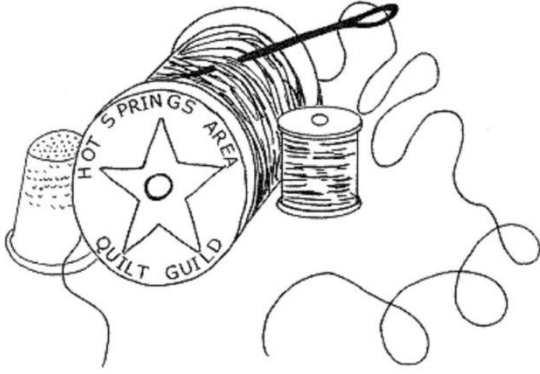

Holly brought many beautiful items that she has made- wall hangings, pillows, stuffed wool pieces and more. She says wool is so easy to appliqué because you do not have to turn under the edges because it does not ravel. She also dyes much of her fabric to get the shades she wants. She sometimes goes to thrift shops and finds wool jackets, skirts, etc. – washes them in hot water, cuts them up and dyes them. Her displays were so pretty because she used many antique tools and utensils to combine with her wool pieces. She also described how to do rug hooking – cutting the wool into thin strips. We all enjoyed her program- thank you, Holly
