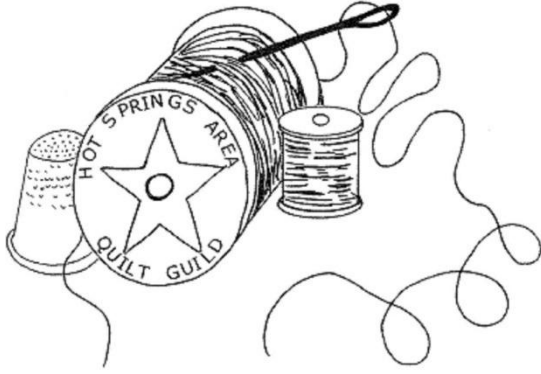

## Kitchen Sink Cookies from Willie Shuck

### Ingredients:

1 cup unsalted butter (2 sticks), softened  
1 cup sugar  
1 cup light brown sugar  
2 large eggs  
1 tsp. vanilla  
2 cups flour  
2 tsp. baking powder  
1 tsp cinnamon  
½ tsp. salt  
¼ tsp nutmeg  
1 large package chocolate chips (2 cups)  
2 cups shredded coconut  
1 ½ cups old-fashioned oats  
1 ½ cups large raisins or Craisins

### Directions:

Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl, beat butter, sugars and eggs. Add eggs one at a time. Add vanilla. On low speed, beat in flour, baking powder, cinnamon, salt and nutmeg. Stir in the rest of the ingredients.

Drop by heaped teaspoons on an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake for 12-15 minutes.

**This recipe was requested after Willie brought some samples to a meeting. She says they are called "Kitchen Sink Cookies" because everything but the kitchen sink is in them!**
